The Lake Park Competition will have a prelim and finals format. The bands that are chosen for the finals performance are chosen by; Top band in each class (A, AA, & AAA) and the next top seven scores regardless of class. If we make one of the top ten scores, we will participate in finals.

When students arrive at Andrew, they may use the telephone in Mr. Iwinski's office to call home. Parents do not need to sit in the parking lot at Andrew waiting for the busses to arrive.

Bus Boarding

Students have already signed up for busses. We have had problems with students trying to save seats or moving other students' belongings. In order to alleviate this situation students are not allowed to save seats or leave belongings on the bus unattended. Students will ride the same bus for the entire season and chaperones will be given a bus attendance list. We will also have bus captains in order to make sure the bus is clean during and after an outing. Students are not to leave their belongings on the bus unattended, nor are students to move belongings of other students. If it does not belong to you, don't touch it. Students will not be allowed to change busses on route back. Stay on the same bus you signed up for!

Student expectations

Students are expected to act in an orderly and respectful fashion at all times to staff, chaperones, and bus and van drivers (we are representing our school). At no time will a student be allowed to wander on their own or leave the group. Since marching band is a school sponsored activity all the rules in the student handbook apply and discipline matters will be handled upon return through the dean's office.

Directions:

Lake Park High School

Take Rt. 45 South to I-80 West to 355 North. Take 355 to Lake Street (Rt 20) west. Go to Bloomingdale road turn right (approx. 1 1/2 mile) and turn left on Bryn Mawr. See Enclosed map for route to the school and detailed directions.

Tickets

Adult tickets are \$10.00. Student and senior tickets are \$7.00. Children 4 and under are free. This is a one-time charge for any portion or all of the preliminary and finals competition. There will be a family plan offered. A family of four, two adults and up to 4 students will cost \$25.00. Only two adults will be allowed in on the family plan, however, extra children will pay \$5.00. There are no advance ticket sales and no reserved seating. Handicap parking is available in the main east parking lot. A special reserved area in front of the ticket sales booth is being reserved. Patrons needing this parking should identify themselves to the volunteer parking directors at the West End Street entrance. Everyone's hand will be stamped upon paying admission. The stamp is necessary to gain entrance into the front stands.

Parking

Parking for visitors is relatively tight. We strongly recommend fans to car pool whenever possible. A portion of the main (east) parking lot will be reserved for Pit and Prop traffic as well as truck and handicap parking. An additional lot is available on the far west end of campus on Bryn Mawr across from the school. After 6:00 p.m. parking will be arranged with the village on designated side streets near the school. The parking lot volunteers will be able to direct you to these.

First Aid

First Aid will be available by paramedics on site. Location is indicated on the enclosed site map.

Band Picture

A band picture will be taken of each group after their preliminary performance by Jolesch Photography. Each band member will be given an opportunity to order one. See letter from Jolesch Photography on back of this sheet for price and delivery information.

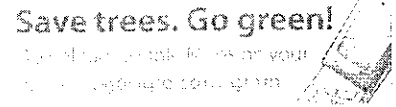

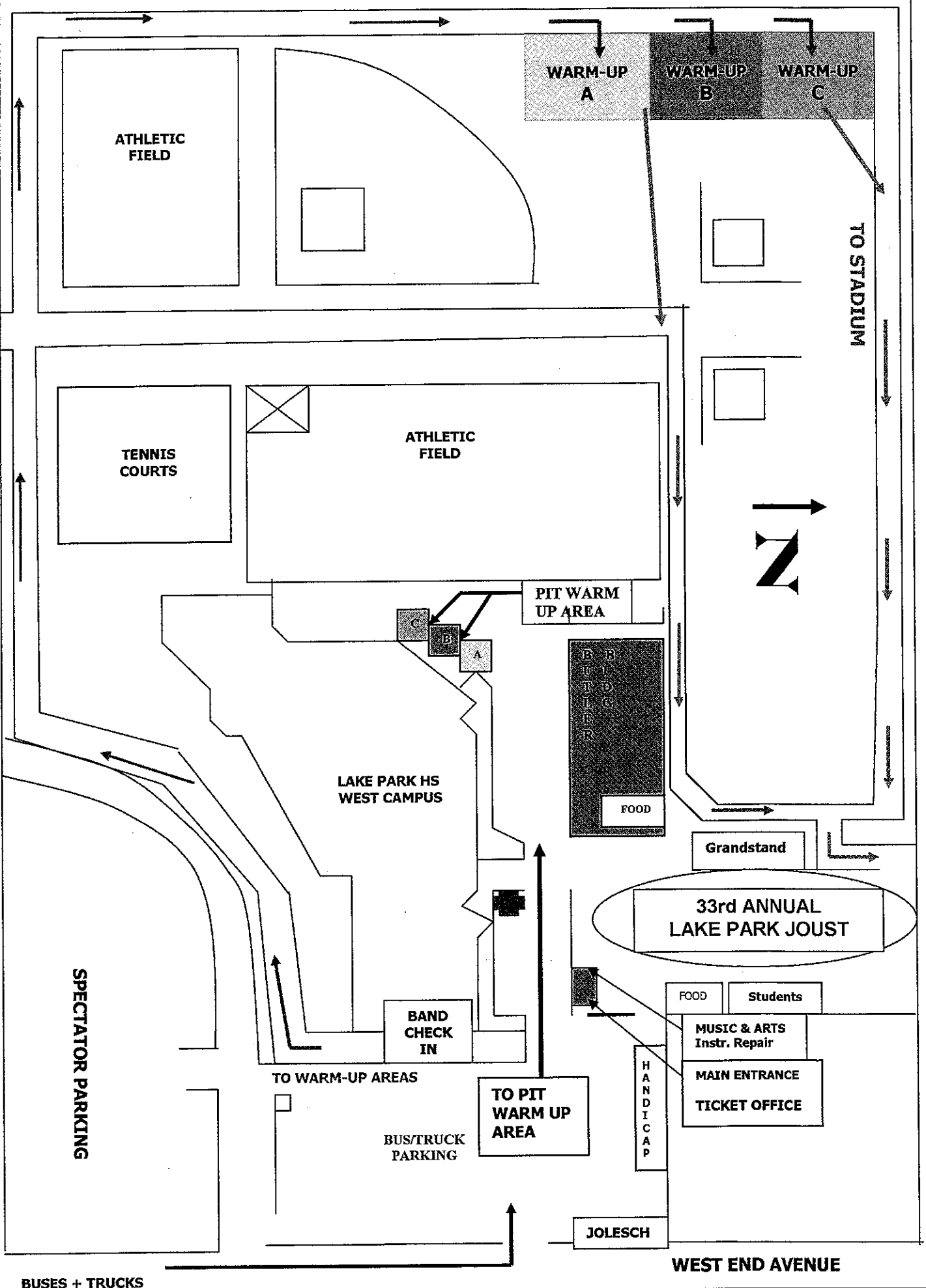
